Rules & Regulations

I. Information about the Competition:

1. **Registration:** 4 May - 12 June 2026
2. **Competition Day:** 4 August 2026 (Tuesday)
3. **Time:** 11:00 AM
4. **Venue:**
 - a. All Participating Units (For schools & educational institutions)
 - b. New Era University College (For individual)

II. Objectives:

1. To highlight the importance of Mathematics as a school curriculum;
2. To discover the participants' talent in Mathematics;
3. To provide resources for participants to engage in Mathematics-related discussions in the classroom or the exchange.

III. Target:

All the primary and secondary schools or institutions in Malaysia.

IV. Categories:

1. Middle Primary (Standard 3 and Standard 4)
2. Upper Primary (Standard 5 and Standard 6)
3. Junior Secondary (Junior Middle 1, Junior Middle 2/ Form 1, Form 2)
4. Intermediate Secondary (Junior Middle 3, Senior Middle 1/ Form 3, Form 4)
5. Senior Secondary (Senior Middle 2, Senior Middle 3/ Form 5, Form 6)

V. Format:

Students are required to solve 25 multiple-choice questions and 5 fill-in integer questions (0 to 999). The time limit for Primary Categories is 60 minutes, and for Secondary Categories is 75 minutes.

VI. Medium:

Bilingual (Simplified Chinese & English)

VII. Participation approaches:

1. Schools and educational institutions - Participants register through their schools or educational institutions. Participating units (i.e., schools or educational institutions) must agree to set up the competition venue by themselves and arrange teachers or staff to invigilate the competition and follow up on post-competition matters. The competition will be held simultaneously in participating units across the competition region on the designated date. The organiser will mail the question papers and answer sheets to each participating unit prior to the competition. After the competition, the participating units must post the answer sheets back to the organiser as soon as possible for evaluation.

2. Individuals - Those who are unable to participate through their schools or educational institutions can register for the competition individually. They will need to complete the competition by arriving at New Era University College on the competition date.

VIII. Registration fee:

RM43 per person (Including RM1 as postage and invigilation allowance for the participating unit or the in-charge person. The participating unit will need to pay RM42 per person in the online registration)

IX. Registration Procedures:

A. By Schools or Educational Institutions -

1. Proceed to the Registration Website (<https://fict.newera.edu.my>) and fill in the details of the participating unit and the person in charge online. Download the Excel format Registration Form.
2. Fill out the participants' details in the Excel format Registration Form.
3. Pay the registration fee online by FPX through the New Era Online Shop (<https://www.newera.edu.my/onlineshop/category/3>).
4. Upload the completed Excel format Registration Form and enter the Order No., e.g., OSPAY_20250415151836872, on the registration website.
5. Submit the registration online.

B. Individuals -

1. Proceed to the Registration Website (<https://fict.newera.edu.my>), fill in the details of the participating unit (New Era University College) and the in-charge person's information (parent's information) online. Download the Excel format Registration Form.
2. Fill out the participants' details in the Excel format Registration Form.
3. Pay the registration fee online by FPX through the New Era Online Shop (<https://www.newera.edu.my/onlineshop/category/3>).
4. Upload the completed Excel format Registration Form and enter the Order No., e.g., OSPAY_20250415151836872, on the registration website.
5. Submit the registration online.

X. Competition Rules:

1. The participants must maintain silence at all times in the competition.
2. Do not open the paper until told to do so.
3. Mobile phones and smart watches are not allowed. If the participants have one, they must give it to an invigilator, who will store it in a safe place.
4. The participants may use printed language dictionaries.
5. For participants of the Middle Primary and Upper Primary Divisions (Primary Schools), they may use calculators; For participants of the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Divisions (Secondary Schools), they may NOT use calculators.
6. The participants may not borrow equipment without an invigilator's permission.
7. The participants must not leave their seats during the competition and remain seated until the competition finishes.
8. If a participant needs to leave the competition room, they must raise their hand and wait for the invigilator to accompany them.
9. If a participant has any other questions, they should raise their hand to seek assistance from the invigilator.

XI. Responsibility:

1. The participating units (schools or educational institutions) must agree to independently set up the examination venue on the designated competition date.
2. The person in charge of the participating units (schools or educational institutions), upon receiving the examination papers, must ensure their strict confidentiality at all times. Apart from counting the papers and verifying the details on the answer sheets for accuracy, they are strictly prohibited from reviewing, studying, or attempting to solve the questions until after the competition date.
3. The participating units (schools or educational institutions) must understand and agree that all questions have been thoroughly and carefully reviewed. The problem statements are clear and contain no errors. Therefore, no further explanation will be provided.
4. Should any provision of these regulations be deemed incomplete or inadequate, the organizing authority reserves the right to amend, supplement, or make final determinations at its sole discretion at any time.
